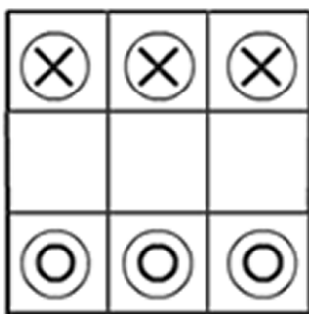


Seega - Egyptian Activity Sheet

This is an ancient 2-player game but is still played by young Egyptians today. It is easy to play and has similarities to the game 'noughts and crosses' which you might already know.

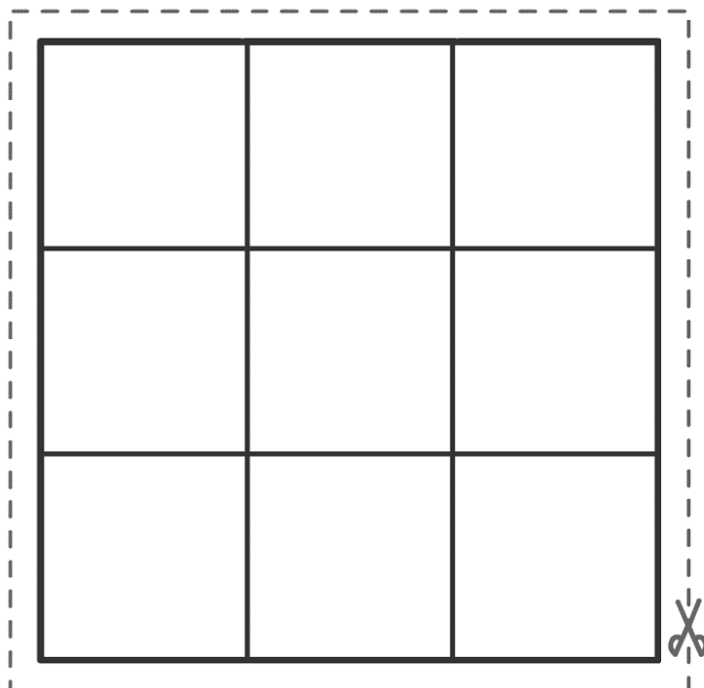
1. Cut out the board and each of the 6 playing pieces, along the dotted lines.
2. Decide which player is going to be 'X' and which is going to be 'O'
3. Set up the board, as show in the picture below.

Players take it in turns to move 1 of their pieces either 1 or 2 squares on the board. Players can move in any direction but cannot pass over another piece. The winner of the game is the first player to get their 3 pieces in a straight line (diagonal included), other than the starting line.
